La Corsa più Medievale della Terra!

Montebello Castle: **GREENSLEEVES**

GENRE: medieval music

REASON: the musical genre is perfectly suited to the location

Artore: **TRI PER DÜ**

GENRE: Ticino and Lombard dialect folk

REASON: their songs - *La Teresina, La bella la va al fosso* - speak of washing clothes, fountains, etc., and in Artore there is the only wash-house in all the hamlets of the Bellinzona district; in addition, the Tri per dü had the opportunity one year to play the Tirlingada, an exclusive tradition in Artore in the Bellinzona area (but not only) of ringing bells by hand at village festivals

Sasso Corbaro Castle: **NÜM DAL CORNO GROUP**

GENRE: swiss instrumental music with the alphorn

REASON: Sasso Corbaro Castle is the place where the group historically rehearses on fine weather weekend days

Forest above Artore: **THEHURDYGURDYMAN (Fredy Conrad)**

GENRE: Barberia little organ

REASON: Fredy Conrad is one of the Tri per dü who played the Tirlingada one year, an exclusive tradition in Artore in the Bellinzona region (but not only) of ringing bells by hand at village festivals; moreover, in the repertoire of his barrel organ there is a roll featuring *Frère Jacques*, a song par excellence dedicated to bells

Nucleus of Daro: **MUSIC OF DARO**

GENRE: band music

REASON: Music of Daro is... of Daro

Piazza del Sole (Sun Square): **THE NOWHERE LAND** Bellinzona Beatles Days Festival

GENRE: Beatles tribute band

REASON: Piazza del Sole (Sun Square) is, for the people of Bellinzona and beyond, the festival square dedicated to the Beatles

Vela Quarter: **SCARP DA TENNIS BAND**

GENRE: dialectal rock d'auteur

REASON: for many years, the band's rehearsal space was located in the Vela Quarter

Underpass of Castel Grande Wall: **ANTEGNATI ORGAN** Antegnati Organ Festival

GENRE: organ music

REASON: in the underpass of the Murata of Castel Grande Castle will be played *The Missa Apostolorum* by Andrea Gabrieli, recorded in 2001, under the direction of Giovanni Conti, in the Collegiate Church, home of the ancient Antegnati Organ. The work, composed in the second half of the 1500s, is perhaps not perfectly suited to the location either in terms of genre (a mass) or era (the Murata of the Castel Grande Castle was built in 1486/'87), but the one selected by the promoters is the only logistical situation on the routes where it can be broadcast in order to make at its best the sound of the precious instrument built in 1588 by the most famous member of the Antegnati family of organ builders from Brescia: Graziadio Antegnati!

Castel Grande (inner courtyard): **CORO CASTELGRANDE**

GENRE: choral singing

REASON: the choir bears the name of the castle in which it is scheduled to perform

## THE DELTA GROOVE

GENRE: Blues

REASON: Piazza Governo (Government Square) is, for the people of Bellinzona and beyond, the festival square dedicated to the Blues: first Piazza Blues and then Bellinzona Blues
